APPLICATION OF TARIFF

This tariff applies to the furnishing of Blue Ridge Digital Phone Company, defined herein, as the "Company". Blue Ridge Local Service is furnished for the use of end users in placing and/or receiving local telephone calls within a Local Calling Area.

Services, features, and functions will be provided where facilities, including but not limited to billing and technical capabilities, are available.

The provision of Blue Ridge Digital Phone Co. is subject to existing regulations and terms and conditions specified in this Tariff and the Company's other tariffs and service guides, and may be revised, added to, or supplemented by superseding issues.

In addition to the regulations and charges herein, this Tariff is subject to specific regulations as set forth in the Pennsylvania Code Title 52 Public Utilities, and other regulations as may be prescribed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

SECTION 1 - DEFINITIONS

<u>Access Line</u> - An arrangement which connects the customer's location to the Company's designated point of presence or network switching center.

<u>Account</u> - The customer who has agreed, verbally or by signature, to honor the terms of service established by the Company. An account may have more than one access line billed to the same customer address.

<u>Authorized User</u> - A person, firm or corporation, or any other entity authorized by the customer to communicate utilizing the Company's service.

<u>Broadband Local Service</u> - Broadband Local Service provides the customer with an access line and usage within a Local Service Area for the transmission of two-way interactive switched voice or data communications.

<u>Company</u> - Whenever used in this Tariff, "Company", or "Blue Ridge" refers to Blue Ridge Digital Phone Company unless otherwise specified. Blue Ridge Digital Phone Company

<u>Customer</u> - The person or legal entity that subscribes to service under this Tariff and is responsible for payment of tariffed charges for services furnished to the customer.

<u>Customer Premises</u> - The customer premises is all space in the same building occupied by a customer and all space occupied by the same customer in different buildings on contiguous property.

<u>Exchange Area</u> - The geographic territory established by the Company and approved by the Commission for the provision of local telecommunications services.

<u>Local Service Area</u> - A local service area is the region, comprised of one or more exchange areas, within which a customer can call another station at the rates and charges as specified in this Tariff.

"Public Utility Commission" or "Commission" - The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

<u>Residential Local Service</u> - Service is classified and charged for as Residential Service where the primary use of the service is of a domestic nature and where the business use, if any, is merely incidental.

2.1 UNDERTAKING OF THE COMPANY

2.1.1 GENERAL

The Company undertakes to provide the services offered in this Tariff on the terms and conditions and at the rates and charges specified herein.

The Company's services and facilities are provided on a monthly basis unless otherwise indicated, and are available 24 hours per day, seven days per week. A month is considered to have 30 days for the purpose of computing charges in this Tariff.

Services, features and functions will be provided where facilities, including but not limited to billing and technical capabilities, are available without unreasonable expense to the Company.

2.1.2 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Customers may be required to enter into written service orders which shall contain or reference a specific description of the service ordered, the rates to be charged, the duration of the services, and the terms and conditions in this Tariff. The Customer may also be required to execute any other documents as may reasonably be requested by the Company in connection with the provisioning of Local Service.

2.1.3 PROVISION OF EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES

- A. The Company shall use reasonable efforts to make available services to a customer on or before a particular date, subject to the provisions of and compliance by the customer with the regulations contained in this Tariff. The Company does not guarantee availability, except as stated or expressly provided for in this Tariff.
- B. The Company shall use reasonable efforts to maintain facilities and equipment used to provide services that it furnishes to the customer. The customer may not, nor may the customer permit others to rearrange, disconnect, remove, attempt to repair, or otherwise interfere with any of the facilities or equipment installed by the Company, except upon the written consent of the Company.
- C. Equipment the Company provides or installs at the customer premises for use in connection with the services the Company offers shall not be used for any purpose other than that for which the Company provides, installs, or has installed on its behalf.
- D. The Customer shall be responsible for the payment of service charges, as set forth herein, for visits by the Company's agents or employees to the premises of the customer when the service difficulty or trouble report results from the use of equipment or facilities provided by any party other than the Company, including but not limited to the customer.

- E. The Company shall not be responsible for the installation, operation or maintenance of any customer-provided communications equipment. Where such equipment is connected to the facilities furnished pursuant to this Tariff, the responsibility of the Company shall be limited to the furnishing of facilities offered under this Tariff and to the maintenance and operation of such facilities. The customer is responsible for ensuring that customer-provided equipment and wiring connected to Company equipment and facilities is compatible with Company-provided equipment and facilities.
- F. Equipment that the Company provides or installs at a customer premises for use in connection with the telephone services shall remain the property of the Company. If the customer cancels service or the Company lawfully terminates, discontinues, suspends or refuses to continue providing service to the customer, the Company has the right to recover this equipment. The Company shall contact the customer for permission to enter the customer's premises to remove this equipment and the customer shall not unreasonably refuse such entry. If the customer refuses to allow removal of this equipment, the customer shall be liable to the Company for the actual cost of the equipment plus administrative costs and attorney's fees. These fees may be added to the customer's telephone bill and the customer agrees to pay these fees. The customer shall assume responsibility for any and all such unrecovered equipment.

2.1.4 RELEASE OF INFORMATION TO CARRIERS

The Company will provide information to a Carrier who needs the information for allocation, billing or service purposes in compliance with all State and Federal requirements applicable to Customer Proprietary Network Information (CPNI).

2.1.5 CUSTOMER EQUIPMENT

A customer may transmit or receive information or signals via the facilities of the Company by use of customer-provided equipment.

A. Station Equipment

Customer-provided terminal equipment on the customer premises, and the electric power consumed by such equipment, shall be provided by and maintained at the expense of the customer. Additionally, the customer shall maintain the Company-provided equipment, and the electric power consumed by such equipment shall be at the expense of the customer.

The customer is responsible for ensuring that customer-provided equipment connected to Company equipment and facilities is compatible with Company equipment and facilities. The magnitude and character of the voltages and currents impressed on Company-provided equipment and wiring by the connection, operation or maintenance of such equipment and wiring must be such as not to cause damage to the Company-provided equipment and wiring or injury to the Company's employees or other persons. If the Company, in its sole discretion, reasonably determines that additional protective equipment is required to prevent such damage or injury, it shall be provided at the customer's expense.

B. Inspections

Upon reasonable notification to the customer, and at a reasonable time, the Company may take such tests and inspections as may be necessary to determine that the customer is complying with the requirements specified in this Tariff.

If the customer fails to comply with the protective requirements described in A., above, the Company may take such action as it deems necessary to protect its facilities, equipment and personnel. The Company may, immediately and without notice, deny service when the customer (a) subjects Company or non-Company personnel to hazardous conditions; (b) circumvents the Company's ability to charge for its services, prevent and protect against fraud; or (c) acts in a way that may cause immediate harm to the local network or other Company services.

2.1.6 ABUSE AND FRAUDULENT USE

Service is furnished subject to the condition that there will be no abuse or fraudulent use of the service. The Company may, in accordance with Section 2.4 following, discontinue, suspend, or refuse to furnish any and/or all service(s) without incurring any liability if the Company deems that such action is necessary to prevent or to protect against abuse or fraud or to otherwise protect its personnel, agents, facilities, assets or services.

Except for willful misconduct, the discontinuance or suspension of service by the Company does not relieve the customer of any obligation to pay the Company for charges due and owed for service furnished up to the time of discontinuance or suspension.

A. Abuse

The abuse of service is prohibited. The following activities constitute abuse:

- 1. Using the service to make calls which might reasonably be expected to frighten, abuse, torment or harass another.
- 2. Using the service in such a way that it interferes unreasonably with the use of the service by others.
- 3. Establishing a pattern of behavior with respect to the Company that is intended to vex, harass, threaten or annoy the Company, its employees or agents. A pattern of behavior is intended to vex, harass, threaten or annoy if its purpose is to disturb, irritate or interrupt the Company's operations through continued and repeated acts.

B. Fraudulent Use

The fraudulent use of, or the intended or attempted fraudulent use of, the service is prohibited. The following activities constitute fraudulent use:

- 1. Rearranging, tampering with, or making connections not authorized by this Tariff to any service components used to furnish local service.
- 2. Using the service with the intent of gaining access to another customer's outbound calling capabilities on an unauthorized basis.
- 3. Using fraudulent means or devices, tricks, schemes, false or invalid numbers, false representation, false credit devices or electronic devices to defraud or mislead callers.
- 4. Refusing to provide, or providing false information to the Company regarding the customer's identity, address, credit worthiness, current or past use of telecommunications services or its planned use of the Company's service.
- 5. Refusing to provide payment or security for the payment for service(s), advance payments or deposits as specified in this Tariff.
- 6. Placing or receiving calls with the intent of defrauding the Company.

2.2.1 SERVICE LIABILITY

- A. With respect to any other claim or suit by a customer or by any others, for damages associated with the installation, provision, preemption, termination, maintenance, repair or restoration of a service, and subject to the provisions following, the Company's liability, if any, shall not exceed an amount equal to the proportionate charge for the service for the period during which the service was affected. In no event shall the Company be liable for special reliance, consequential or other such damages. This liability for damages shall be in addition to any amounts that may otherwise be due the customer under this Tariff as a Credit Allowance for Interruptions.
- B. The Company is not liable for any act or omission of any other communications utility which furnishes a portion of a service.
- C. The Company is not liable for damages to a premises resulting from the furnishing of service including the installation and removal of equipment or facilities and associated wiring, unless the damage is caused by the Company's negligence.

- D. The Company shall be indemnified, defended, and held harmless against any claim, loss or damage arising from the use of service offered under this Tariff, involving:
 - 1. Claims for libel, slander, invasion of privacy, or infringement of copyright arising from any communication;
 - 2. Claims for patent infringement arising from the customer or authorized user combining or using the service furnished by the Company in connection with facilities or equipment furnished by others; or
 - 3. All other claims arising out of any act or omission of others in the course of using services provided pursuant to this Tariff.
- E. The Company does not guarantee or make any warranty with respect to its services when used in an explosive atmosphere. The Company shall be indemnified, defended and held harmless by the customer and authorized user from any and all claims by any person relating to the services so provided.
- F. No license under patents (other than the limited license to use) is granted by the Company or shall be implied or arise by estoppel, with respect to any service offered under this Tariff. The Company will defend the customer and authorized user against claims of patent infringement arising solely from the use by the customer or authorized user of services offered under this Tariff and will indemnify such customer or authorized user for any damages awarded based solely on such claims.

2.2.2 TEMPORARY SUSPENSION FOR REPAIRS

The Company shall have the right to make necessary repairs or changes in its facilities at any time and will have the right to suspend or interrupt service temporarily for the purpose of making the necessary repairs or changes in its system. When such suspension or interruption of service for any appreciable period is necessary, the Company will give the customers who may be affected reasonable notice thereof as circumstances permit, and will perform the work with reasonable diligence and, if practicable, at times that will cause the customer the least inconvenience. When the Company is repairing or changing its facilities, it shall take appropriate precautions to avoid unnecessary interruptions of communications or customer's service.

2.2.3 CREDIT ALLOWANCE FOR INTERRUPTIONS

It shall be the obligation of the customer to notify the Company immediately of any interruption in service for which a credit allowance is desired. Before giving such notice, the customer shall ascertain that the trouble is not within his or her control, or is not in wiring or equipment furnished by the customer and connected to the Company's terminal.

When main telephone service is interrupted for a period of at least 24 hours, the Company, after due notice by the customer, shall apply the following schedule of allowances except in situations as provided in Paragraph 3 following.

- 1. 1/30 of the tariff monthly rate of all services and facilities furnished by the Company rendered inoperative by the Company to the extent of being useless for each of the first three full 24-hour periods during which the interruption continues after notice by the customer, when the out-of-service period extends beyond a minimum period of 24 hours.
- 2. 2/30 of each full 24-hour period beyond the first three 24 hour periods. However, in no instance shall the allowance for the out-of-service period exceed the total charges in a billing period for the service and facilities furnished by the Company rendered inoperative to the extent of being useless.
- 3. When service is interrupted for a period of at least 24 hours due to such factors as storms, fires, floods or other conditions beyond the control of the Company, an allowance of 1/30 of the tariff monthly rate for all services and facilities furnished by the Company rendered inoperative to the extent of being useless shall apply for each full 24 hours during which the interruption continues after notice by the customer to the Company.

The foregoing allowances shall not be applicable where service is interrupted by the negligence or willful act of the customer to service, or where the Company pursuant to the terms of the contract for service suspends or terminates service for non-payment of charges or for unlawful or improper use of facilities or for any other reason provided for in this Tariff.

2.2.4 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

A. Unauthorized Computer Intrusion

With respect to any other claim or suit by a subscriber, common carrier, reseller, or any other party for damages caused by, or associated with, any unauthorized computer intrusion, including but no limited to the input of damaging information such as a virus, time bomb, any unauthorized access, interference, alteration, destruction, theft of, or tampering with, a Company computer, switch, data, database, software, information, network or other similar system, the Company's liability, if any, shall not exceed an amount equal to the proportionate charge by the Company for the service for the period during which the service provided by the Company was affected or so utilized.

Each subscriber of the Company shall be responsible for providing appropriate security measures to protect the subscriber's computer, data, or telecommunications network.

B. Transmission of Data

The Company shall not be held liable for any damage, harm or loss of data caused by the subscriber using the Company's voice-grade telephone access lines and/or facilities for the transmission of data. The Company's liability shall be limited to errors or damages to the transmission of voice messages over these facilities, and the liability shall be limited to an amount equal to the proportionate amount of the Company's billing for the period of service during which the errors or damages occur.

C. Unauthorized Devices

The Company shall not be held liable or responsible for any damage or harm that may occur as the result of unauthorized devices or the failure of the Company to detect unauthorized devices on the subscriber's line.

2.3 PAYMENTS AND CHARGES

2.3.1 ESTABLISHMENT AND REESTABLISHMENT OF CREDIT

In order to insure the payment of all charges due from its services, the Company may require a customer to establish and maintain his credit in one of the following ways: 1) by furnishing references suitable to the Company; 2) by providing a suitable guarantee in writing, in form prescribed by the Company; 3) by means of a cash deposit.

2.3.2 BILLING AND COLLECTION

The customer is responsible for payment of all charges for equipment or facilities and services furnished by the Company to the customer.

The Company will establish a monthly billing date for each customer account and shall bill all charges incurred by and credits due to the customer under this Tariff. Recurring charges are billed in advance of the month(s) in which service is provided, except where prohibited by law. Usage sensitive charges will be billed for the preceding billing period. Recurring charges and usage sensitive charges for the Federal Government will be billed in arrears. Bills are due by the payment due date shown on the bill.

When the customer's service does not begin on the first day of the billing cycle or end on the last day of the billing cycle, the charge for the fraction of the billing cycle in which service was furnished will be calculated on a pro rata basis or a bill credit may be applied for the fraction of the billing cycle in which service was not furnished.

2.3.3 BILLING DISPUTES

The customer is responsible for notifying the Company of any charges in dispute and the specific basis of such dispute. All charges not in dispute shall be paid by the customer by the payment due date. Upon notification of a dispute, the Company shall undertake an investigation of the disputed charges. At the conclusion of the investigation, the Company shall notify the customer of any amount determined by the Company to be correctly charged and such amount shall become immediately due and owing. Amounts determined by the Company to be correctly charged shall also be subject to the late payment charge specified in this Tariff. 2.3.4 ADVANCE PAYMENTS

The Company may require a customer to make an advance payment before services and facilities are furnished in the following cases: 1) the construction of facilities and furnishing of special equipment, or 2) temporary service for short-term use. The advance payment will not exceed an amount equal to the nonrecurring charge(s) and one month's charges for the service or facility. In addition, where special construction is involved, the advance payment may also include an amount equal to the estimated nonrecurring charges for the special construction. The advance payment will be credited to the customer's initial bill. An advance payment may be required in addition to a deposit.

2.3.5 DEPOSITS

Deposits may be required from customers whose credit history is unacceptable or unavailable. Deposits will be collected and returned in accordance with Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code, Chapter 64.31-64.41.

The fact that a deposit may have been made in no way relieves the applicant or subscriber from complying with the Company's regulations as to the prompt payment of bills or constitutes a waiver or modification of the regular practices providing for discontinuance of service for non-payment of any sums due the Company for service rendered.

2.3.6 RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

The customer will be assessed a charge of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each check, draft, or electronic funds transfer, in addition to any late payment charges as specified in Section 2.3.7, submitted by the customer to the Company which a financial institution refuses to honor.

2.3.7 LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

Where payment of any billed amount is not received within fifteen (15) days after the due date, the unpaid balance carried forward to the next month's bill may be subject to a late payment charge. The late payment charge on an overdue bill will not exceed 1.25% per month on the full unpaid and overdue balance of the bill. These charges will be calculated only on the overdue portions of the bill. The rate, when annualized will not exceed 15% per annum – computed by the simple interest method – and will not include previously accrued late payment charges. A late payment charge will not be assessed against an outstanding security deposit. Late payment charges do not apply to the disputed amounts portion of unpaid balances, if resolved in favor of the customer.

2.4 CANCELLATION AND DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

2.4.1 CANCELLATION OF SERVICE

The customer may cancel service at any time upon written or oral notice to the Company. Upon such termination the customer shall be responsible for the payment of all charges due. This includes all charges due for the period service has been rendered plus any unexpired portion of an initial service period or applicable termination charges, or both.

2.4.2 DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

- B. The Company may suspend service under the following conditions provided that, unless otherwise stated, the Customer shall be given seven (7) days written notice to comply with any rule or remedy any deficiency:
 - .1 Nonpayment of an undisputed delinquent account or the undisputed portion of an account where a dispute exists as to part but not all of an amount billed by the Company;
 - .2 Failure to post a deposit, provide a guarantee or establish credit;
 - .3 Unreasonable refusal to permit access to service connections, equipment and other property of the LEC for maintenance or repair;
 - .4 The use of service so as to interfere with or impair the use of service rendered to other customers;
 - .5 Failure to comply with the material terms of a payment agreement;
 - .6 Fraud or material misrepresentation of identity to obtain telephone service;
 - .7 Violation of tariff provisions on file with the Commission so as to threaten the safety of a person or the integrity of the service delivery system of the Company;
 - .8 Unpaid indebtedness for telephone service previously furnished by the Company in the name of the Customer within four (4) years of the date the bill is rendered.
- C. When at least 10 days have passed since suspension of service, the Company may terminate for failure to pay a reconnection fee and to remedy the original grounds for suspension due to any of the following reasons: (1) failure to make satisfactory arrangements to pay arrearages; (2) Failure to post a deposit, furnish a third-party guarantee or otherwise establish credit; (3) failure to meet the requirements of a payment agreement; (4) failure to give adequate assurances that an unauthorized use or practice will cease.

4.2 SERVICE CONNECTION AND LINE ACTIVATION CHARGES

4.2.1 DESCRIPTION OF CHARGES

A Service Connection Charge or Line Activation Charge applies when a customer requests establishment of new service. The requirement to install certain facilities or equipment, or the presence of such facilities or equipment, will determine whether the Service Connection Charge or the Line Activation Charge will apply.

- A. The Service Connection Charge applies per occurrence for the initial or subsequent installation of broadband facilities and equipment, and to any change of location of such facilities and equipment.
- B. The Primary Line Activation Charge applies per occurrence where existing broadband facilities and equipment (with sufficient capacity to meet the activation requirement) are available. Where existing facilities are not available, a Service Connection Charge applies in lieu of the Primary Line Activation Charge.
- C. The Additional Line Activation Charge applies per occurrence for additional lines where existing broadband facilities and equipment (with sufficient capacity to meet the activation requirement) are available. Where existing facilities are not available a Service Connection Charge applies. The Additional Line Activation Charge will be waived if the Service Connection Charge or Primary Line Activation Charge applies.
- D. The Line Restoration Charge will apply on each line to be restored after disconnection for reasons stated in Section 2.4.2.
- E. The Service Dispatch Charge will apply for any subsequent request to add or modify facilities.

Primary Interexchange Carrier (PIC) Change Charge A PIC Change Charge will apply to existing customers who request a change in their PIC designation for pre-subscription of interLATA or intraLATA services. If the Customer simultaneously changes both the intraLATA PIC and the interLATA PIC on the same line or trunk to the same Carrier, only the interLATA PIC Change Charge will apply. If the Customer simultaneously changes both the intraLATA PIC and the interLATA PIC and the interLATA PIC on the same line or trunk to separate Carriers, both the IntraLATA And interLATA PIC Change Charges will apply.
- D. Hunting Configuration Change Charge A charge will apply to each customerrequested change in the hunting configuration.
- E. Change of Billing Responsibility This charge applies when a customer requests that the billing responsibility for an existing Residential Local Service account be changed to reflect a new name.
- F. Directory Listing Change Charge A charge will apply to each customerrequested change in directory listing.

6.4 OPERATOR SERVICES

6.4.1 GENERAL

A service charge will apply to local calls placed with the assistance of a Company Operator or mechanized response system. Various billing arrangements are available with Operator Assisted Service including Operator Station (Collect, Billed to Third Number, Other Operator Assisted) and Person-to-Person.

6.4.2 OPERATOR ASSISTED SERVICES

Customers who cannot physically dial a call can qualify for an Operator Assisted exemption, which provides the customer with operator assistance at a direct dialed rate without a service charge. No application or certification is required for this program; however, the customer must request this exemption.

A. Operator Station

An Operator Station service charge applies when calls are completed with the assistance of a Company Operator, except as specified for Person-to-Person calls.

B. Person-to-Person

Person-to-Person charges apply when the calling party specifies to the operator a particular person to be reached, or a particular station, department, or office to be reached through a PBX or Centrex attendant. After the called station has been reached, if the called party is unavailable and the calling party requests or agrees to speak to a party other than the party initially specified, the call is still billed as a Person-to-Person call. The calling party is responsible for identifying the party at the called station.

6.5 DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE SERVICE

6.5.1 GENERAL

Directory Assistance Service is furnished upon customer request for assistance in obtaining directory listing information for listings that are within the local calling area of LATA of the originating line. Customers will be charged for all requests including requests for listings that are not available or not found.

6.5.2 REGULATIONS

Directory Assistance charges apply on a per call basis, with a maximum of three requests allowed per call. Calls to Directory Assistance service will be billed directly to the customer's account. Alternate billing options and operator services are not available.

A. Monthly Call Allowance

The Directory Assistance service charge will be waived for the first two direct dialed local Directory Assistance calls per month per local exchange service line. Call allowances or calls are not transferable between separate accounts of the same customer.

B. Exemptions

The Directory Assistance Service Charge is not applicable to the following types of calls:

- 1. Calls from patients in hospitals, skilled nursing homes and convalescent homes which have been properly licensed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and which have as their predominant undertaking the surgical, medical and nursing care of the sick and disabled.
- 2. Calls placed from residence telephones where a member of the customer's household has been certified by a registered physician or a designated agency as unable to use a directory because of a visual or physical handicap.

6.7 BUSY LINE VERIFICATION AND INTERRUPT SERVICE

6.7.1 GENERAL

Upon request of a calling party, the Operator will verify a busy condition on a called line. The Operator will determine whether the line is clear or in use and report its status to the calling party. The Operator will interrupt the call on the called line only if the calling party indicates an emergency and requests interruption.

6.7.2 REGULATIONS

- A. Busy Line Verification and Interrupt service is furnished where and to the extent that facilities permit. The customer shall indemnify and hold the Company harmless against all claims that may arise from either party to the interrupted call or any person.
- B. A charge will apply when: (1) the operator verifies that the line is busy with a call in progress, (2) the operator verifies that the line is available for incoming calls; or (3) the operator verifies that the called number is busy with a call in progress and the customer requests interruption. The operator will then interrupt the call, advising the called party of the name of the calling party. Charges apply for both verification and interruption.
- C. No charge will apply when: (1) the calling party advises that the call is to or from an official public emergency agency; or (2) under conditions other than those stated in A. above.
- D. A Busy Line Verification charge also applies for each Busy Line Interruption.

6.9.1 GLOSSARY OF TERMS

<u>Host Telephone Company</u>: The service provider, which is also the telecommunications public utility that provides 9-1-1 service to the county/municipality, and that houses the Automatic Location Identification (ALI)/MSAG data used for providing 9-1-1 service.

<u>MSAG Content</u>: The data elements of the MSAG (Master Street Address Guide) including, (but not necessarily limited to) the data elements that are entered into the following fields A-I of a standard MSAG record:

- A. Tax area record
- B. Locality
- C. Street
- D. Thoroughfare
- E. Directional [where required]
- F. Even (E), Odd (O), or All (A) [applied to house numbers]
- G. Low-High range of house numbers
- H. PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point)
- I. LAT/LONG (Latitude/Longitude) [where required]

<u>MSAG Formatting, Format</u>: Shall include changes to the identity of fields, order of fields, and number and arrangement of data elements in each field, and a telephone company's rearrangement or regrouping of such data, without changing the MSAG content, for purposes of validating against MSAG records.

<u>Telephone Company</u>: A telecommunications public utility regulated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and which has or requests access to the county/municipality 9-1-1 system or connection to the serving selective router, including, but not limited to, local exchange carriers and competitive local exchange carriers. This term is synonymous with 'service provider'.

<u>Telephone Company system</u>: Reference to a service provider's own facilities-based network or, if operating as a nonfacilities-based competitive local exchange carrier, the facilities contracted by the Telephone Company for provision of service.

6.9 UNIVERSAL EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NUMBER SERVICE (911, E911), (Cont'd.)

6.9.2 GENERAL

The Service Access Code 9-1-1 allows the Customer to reach the appropriate emergency services including police, fire and medical services. Enhanced 9-1-1 has the ability to selectively route an emergency call to the primary 9-1-1 provider so that it reaches the correct emergency service located closest to the caller. In addition, the Customer's address and telephone information will be displayed to the primary 9-1-1 provider for display at the Public Answering Point (PSAP).

Pursuant to the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act (Act 78 of 1990), as amended, the Telephone Company collects a fee from its Customers on behalf of the counties in its operating area to support the 9-1-1 system. Counties of the first through second class may impose a monthly contribution rate in an amount not to exceed \$1.00 per line on each local exchange access line. Counties of the third through fifth class may impose a monthly contribution rate in an amount not to exceed \$1.24 per line on each local exchange access line. Counties of the sixth through the eigth class may impose a monthly contribution rate not to exceed \$1.50 per line on each local exchange access line. The contribution rate may be used by counties for the expenses of implementing, expanding or upgrading a 9-1-1 system.

Parties dialing 9-1-1 waive the privacy afforded by non-listed and non-published service to the extent that the telephone number, names and address associated with the originating station location are furnished to the PSAP.

6.9.3 REGULATIONS

- A. The Telephone Company, whether supplying service through its own facilities or the use of an underlying carrier, will comply with the Protocols as set forth in, and in the form of Service Provider E-9-1-1 Protocols, Service Provider E-9-1-1 Questionnaire and Testing Procedures in accordance with the Petition of Bell Atlantic-Pennsylvania, Inc., for a Declaratory Order Relating to the Provision of master Street Address Guides; Docket No. P-0097 1203; Settlement Agreement of all Parties and Joint Petition entered August 7, 1998 MSAG Order.
- B. The Telephone Company is indemnified under the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act, Act 78 of 1990.
- C. The Telephone Company's liability and insurance provisions are fully stated in its tariff's General Regulations.

- D. Cases of Service interruptions affecting public health and safety shall receive priority attention under any and all conditions, particularly in time of disaster. Every appropriate resource will be utilized. The service provider will make reasonable best efforts to have its system fully functional as soon as possible, unless conditions beyond the service provider's control prevent service restoration.
- E. The Telephone Company will not use the county's/municipality's MSAG for any purpose that is not directly related to and required for the provision of 9-1-1 service.

The Telephone Company shall not otherwise modify the content of the MSAG, but may make formatting changes approved by the county/municipality necessary to enable the MSAG to conform to the Telephone Company's information system(s). The request shall be in writing and shall set forth in reasonable detail the formatting changes and all reasons in support. The county/municipality shall respond to the request in ten (10) business days or the request is deemed to be approved. The request shall be granted provided the formatting change does not impair the integrity and accuracy of the MSAG database. For the purposes of this regulation, a content or formatting change does not include the use of the MSAG content in telephone companies' operational support systems to validate customer information for input to the ALI database.
- H. The Telephone Company will not sell, lease, rent, loan or provide, or transfer the county's/municipality's MSAG to any other person(s) or entity(ies) without the expresss written authorization of the county's/municipality's 9-1-1 coordinator, or his or her designee.
- I. The Telephone Company will not, without the written consent of the county/municipality, modify or create any derivative of the county's municipality's MSAG, except as follows: one (1) mirror image copy of the MSAG may be made in electronic form for archival purposes (the copy may be made in read/write format by the host telephone company, but shall be made solely in read-only format by all other telephone companies), and the telephone company may make a mirror image copy, solely in read-only format and only for database reconciliation, address verification for new connections of service, the other functions that are necessary to ensure that the name and address information provided by the service provider to the county/municipality is accurate and conforms to the county's municipality's MSAG format.

6.10 PENNSYLVANIA TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY SERVICE (TRS)

6.10.1 GENERAL

The Pennsylvania Telecommunications Relay Service (PA TRS) is a relay telecommunication service for the deaf, hard of hearing, hearing and/or speech disabled population of the Commonwealth. The PA TRS is mandated by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 to provide functionally equivalent telephone services that are available to other U.S. citizens, at no additional cost. The PA TRS includes both traditional relay (devices such as Teletypewriters (TTY) and Telecommunication Devices for the Deaf (TDD)) and captioned-telephone voice-carry-over relay services (captioned telephone). These relay services permit telephone communications between individuals with hearing and/or speech disabilities, who must use a TTY, TDD or captioned telephone, with individuals having normal hearing and speech. Additionally, 711 abbreviated dialing is available to access the PA TRS. The Company's switching equipment is arranged to translate the "711" calls to the assigned toll-free number, (888) 895-1197, in order to route calls to the Telecommunications Relay Service Provider, in accordance with Commission's Order entered on February 4, 2000 at Docket No. M-00900239.

6.10.2 SURCHARGE

In addition to the charges provided in this tariff, a surcharge will apply to all residence and business access lines served by this Company. (Access lines are those lines extending from the telephone company's central office to the end-user's premises.).This surcharge applies regardless of whether or not the access line uses the PA TRS.

The surcharge serves as the funding vehicle for the operation of the PA TRS, Telecommunications Device Distribution Program and the Print Media Access Service Program and shall be calculated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the Commission). The Commission shall compute the PA TRS surcharge each year and notify local exchange carriers of the surcharge amount to be applied for the twelve-month period commencing with July 1 of each year.

The Commission may revise the surcharge more frequently than annually at its discretion.

Tariff revisions will be filed whenever the Commission calculates a new surcharge amount and notifies the Company.

The following surcharge rates apply to all customer bills issued on or after July 1, 2008.

6.11 TOLL PRESUBSCRIPTION

6.11.1. Toll Presubscription is a procedure whereby a customer designates to the Telephone Company the IntraLATA and InterLATA Toll Providers, i.e., Interexchange Carriers (IXCs) which the customer wishes to be the carriers of choice for toll calls. Such calls are automatically directed to the designated carrier(s) without the need to use carrier access codes or additional dialing to direct the calls to the designated carrier. Toll presubscription does not prevent a customer, who has presubscribed to a toll carrier, from using carrier access codes or additional dialing to direct calls to an alternative toll carrier on a per call basis.

Each carrier will have one or more access codes assigned to it for various types of service. When an end user selects a carrier as its preferred IXC, only one access code of that carrier may be incorporated into the switching system of the Telephone Company permitting access to that carrier by the end user without dialing an access code. Should the same end user wish to use other services of the same carrier, it will be necessary for the end user to dial the necessary access code(s) to reach that carrier's other service(s).

An IXC must use Feature Group D (FGD) Switched Access Service to qualify as a presubscription toll provider unless prior arrangements have been made with or by the Telephone Company. IXCs must submit an Access Service Request (ASR) to the Telephone Company.

Selection of toll presubscription provider by an end user is subject to the terms and conditions following.

6.11.2 At the option of the IXCs, the nonrecurring charge for a change in toll presubscription, as provided herein, may be billed to the IXCs, instead of the end user. This may involve charges resulting from end-user initial free choice Preferred Interexchange Carrier (PIC), as specified in C.1 following.

6.11.3 Presubscription Charge Application

1. End user choices for toll presubscription:

Designating an intraLATA and interLATA IXC(s) as primary carrier(s) thereby requiring no access code to access those IXCs' service. End users are not required to choose the same IXC for intraLATA and interLATA toll presubscription. Other nonpresubscribed IXCs are accessed by dialing 10XXX, 101XXXX, or other required codes. Choosing no carrier as a primary carrier thus requiring 10XXX or 101XXXX code dialing to access all IXCs.

- 2. If a new customer cannot decide upon presubscription IXCs, the Telephone Company may extend a 30-day period following completion of the initial service request to make a choice without charge. In the interim, the customer will be assigned as a 'No-PIC' and must dial an access code to make toll calls.
- 3. If an IXC elects to discontinue Feature Group, the IXC is obligated to contact, in writing, all end users who have selected the canceling IXC as their preferred toll provider. The IXC must inform the end users that it is canceling its Feature Group D Service, request that the end user select a new IXC, and state that the canceling IXC will pay the PIC change charge as provided herein. The IXC must provide written notification to the Telephone Company that this activity has taken place. Following the IXC's discontinuance of service, the Telephone Company will bill the canceling IXC the change charge for each end user that is currently designated to the IXC at the time of discontinuance.
- 4. An unauthorized PIC change is a change in the presubscribed IXC that the end user denies authorizing. PIC disputes for end users are resolved through an investigative process.

If an unauthorized change in toll presubscription occurs, the IXC making the unauthorized change will be assessed a charge for unauthorized change in presubscription as provided at the end of this section. In addition, the IXC will be assessed the applicable charge for returning the end user to the preferred IXC.

6.11.4. End User Charge Discrepancy

1. When a discrepancy is determined regarding an end user's designation of a presubscription IXC, the following applies depending upon the situation described:

A signed letter of authorization takes precedence over any order other than subsequent, direct customer contact with the Telephone Company.

When two or more orders are received for an end user line generated by telemarketing, the date field on the mechanized record used to transmit PIC change information will be used as the PIC authorization date. The order with the latest application date/time determines customer choice.

If an end user denies requesting a change in toll presubscription as submitted by an IXC, and the IXC is unable to produce a letter of authorization, signed by the end user, the IXC will be assessed all applicable change charges. The nonrecurring change charges are provided herein. The IXC will also be assessed the presubscription change charge as specified herein, which was previously billed to the end user.

2. Verification of Orders for Telemarketing

Neither the IXC or the Telephone Company shall submit a PIC change order generated by outbound telemarketing unless and until the order has first been confirmed in accordance with the F.C.C.'s current anti-slamming practices and procedures.

6.11.5 PIC Switchback Option-Business/Residence

PIC Switchback is an option under which no investigation activities are performed by the Telephone Company when an end user denies requesting a change in primary toll carrier submitted by the IXCs. The IXC participating in PIC Switchback will be billed the PIC Switchback Charge, and the presubscription change charge, as specified herein, to switch the end user to the end user's previous carrier.

When the Telephone Company is contacted by an end user who denies requesting a change in primary toll carrier, the end user will be credited the charge assessed for the disputed change in carrier, and will be switched back to the previous IXC at no charge. If this service is made available by the Telephone Company, IXCs may subscribe to or cancel PIC Switchback Service on 30 days notice to the Telephone Company by submitting a written request. A letter of authorization from the IXC will not be requested or accepted at a later date in the event of dispute of the charges assessed under the PIC Switchback option.

This option in no way relieves an IXC of the F.C.C. requirements for verifying all PIC orders obtained by outbound telemarketing prior to submitting those orders, or instituting steps to obtain verification of orders submitted to the Telephone Company.

In addition, the end user has the option of initiating a complaint to the F.C.C. or the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services concerning unauthorized changes in toll presubscription.
